The main focus is to provide the skaters with confidence while they learn very basic skating skills such as balance, moving forwards and backwards as well as turning and stopping progressions that are taught through fun and games. <p>CanSkate Oct – Mar (two days/week)</p> <p>Wednesdays AND Fridays 5:40pm-6:20pm</p>	<p>CanSkate is a dynamic learn-to-skate program that focuses on fun, participation and basic skill development. It is a nationally standardized program for ages 3 and up that teaches fundamental movements and basic skating skills needed to take part in any ice sport or to skate as a recreational activity.</p> <p>CanSkate is for beginners of all ages as well as for those wishing to improve their basic skating skills whether their focus is for figure skating, hockey, ringette, speed skating or just skating for fun. Lessons are delivered in a group format. Skaters progress at their own rate and coaches make sessions active by using circuits, teaching aids, upbeat music and a wide variety of activities that create a motivational environment and promote learning.</p>	<p>\$390 (until August 31) \$415 - After August 31</p>
<p>Advanced CanSkate *previously Intermediate*</p> <p>Oct–Mar (100 mins/week) (coaching included)</p> <p>Wednesdays AND Fridays 6:30-7:20pm</p>	<p>The Advanced CanSkate program (previously called Intermediate) is for skaters in CanSkate working on stages 2-6 that show an interest for Figure Skating. While we continue to teach the fundamental skills of each CanSkate stage, skaters are also introduced to the structure of a figure skating class. Both hockey and figure skates can be worn in this program.</p>	<p>\$545 (until August 31) \$570 - After August 31</p>

General Rules and Regulations

1. All skaters, except for the STARSkate Figure Skating levels, MUST wear a CSA approved hockey helmet with a face mask at all times while on the ice. This is for the protection of the skater and will be strictly enforced. SkateCanada mandates helmets up to and including level CanSkate 5.
2. All skaters must be outfitted with proper fitting skates that have full ankle support. Skates that have limited ankle support may cause injury and/or affect a skater's progress in mastering skills. Skaters should be dressed warmly but still be able to move on the ice (i.e. water proof/repellant pants, gloves or mitts, jacket, vest or sweater).
3. No street shoes or boots are allowed on the ice surface. Parents are not allowed on ice surface at any time.
4. It is required that parents/guardians of skaters under 12 remain at the arena in the event of situations in which their skater must exit the ice surface. (ie. Bathroom breaks, illness, or injury)
5. Payment for the program must accompany the registration. Accounts that continue to be delinquent will result in the participant's enrollment being suspended until such time that the account is rectified and all outstanding fees are paid. All registrants must be members in good standing with Skate Canada.
6. **Skaters who wish to withdraw from the skating program up to and including the 3rd week of their program will be refunded the registration fee less the \$36 Skate Canada fee and an administration fee of 20% of the cost of the program. NO refund will be issued after the 3rd week unless accompanied by a Doctor's certificate.**
7. Horseplay, lack of discipline, lack of courtesy and respect for the coaches and other skaters will not be tolerated and will result in the skater's loss of ice privileges.
8. All parents and spectators must watch their skaters from the designated viewing areas, behind the glass or on the bleachers, and not from the hockey players' bench. All skaters must enter and exit the ice by using the doors at the end of the rink and should only enter the rink once coaches/program assistants allow them on the ice.
